Although rotor blades were not seen, it is possible that w/the obj coming directly towards observer under the prevailing light conditions of sunset, that rotor blades were not distinctly visible. Case evaluated as possible helicopter.

Dear Sirs.

At the risk of being considered "unbalanced" I wish to report that on the evening of August 14 (Tues.) my son Michael (age 5 1/2) and I were gazing out of our 6th floor apartment window watching the afterglow on the horizon after the sun had set when we observed a wingless aircraft approaching from a west-south-westerly direction. Nothing obstructed our view. It was, I believe, what has been referred to as a "flying saucer."

When first I realized that I could see no wings, I thought it was merely too distant. It approached straight towards us and although I still expected to identify wings momentarily, I realized that if it were to have wings then it would have to be flying sideways- an impossibility. Soon after first seeing it I could identify on it a blue light on the (my) left side and a red light on the right which seemed to be directly opposite each other.

I said nothing to my son all during this time from the time we first sighted it simultaneously. Unconsciously, I probably desired to see if he was seeing what I saw and the object was so different I was sure he would make a comment. Shortly after sighting it he said, "I don't know what that is, but it's funny." I said, "What is it, a saucer?" (saucer) "But where are the big things?" "I don't know, it's funny, it's funny." "What is it, Mother?" "I don't know, I don't know, I don't know, it's funny, it's funny, it's funny."

I said nothing to my son all during this time from the time we first sighted it simultaneously.
