RPT ALTHOUGH PHENOMENON OBSERVED FOR ALMOST 2 MINUTES. HIGHLY IMPROBABLE THAT THE THREE OBSERVERS IN THE AREA WOULD ALL HAVE HAD THEIR BACKS TURNED TO THE OBJECT AS IT DESCENDED FROM THE SKY.

ALSO TWO OTHER RESTRICTED AREAS WEST AND NORTHWEST OF UFO LOCATION USED FOR AERIAL TRAINING AND EXERCISES. ~~THAT PARTLY INFLATED BALLOON IMMEDIATELY SUBMERGING UNDER WATER UPON IMPACT NOT CONSIDERED VALID. HOWEVER,~~ POSSIBLE FOR ANY NUMBER OF ARMAMENT AND ORDINANCE ITEMS TO HAVE DROPPED OR ACCIDENTALLY DETACHED FROM AIRCRAFT AND FALLING INTO WATER. FOR EXAMPLE, SEMI-DUD BOMB THAT COULD HAVE EXPLODED UNDER WATER OR ANY OTHER TYPE OF PRESSURE DEVICES HEAVY ENOUGH TO SUBMERGE


