I believe the occupants of the saucers must have been psychic because I said to my husband - I wish they would do something to prove they are other than airplanes, and the ones fire drawn and now to bubble up and down like hobby horses and tilted also.

I want to say I wish they would get left as something and they did at that very moment - they released with a hot orange white color - they must have been for sport then because I saw a distinct circle of light from the 4 of them also that reminded white orange and the top that felt red. They came out from the air and faded off.

None of us were afraid or much
impressed - we believe they are extra-
terrestrial and the only thing that concerns
us is if they are friendly or not and
what their purposes are. My husband was
in the Counter Intelligence Corps in
Germany and he has a very high U.S. rank.
He believes the saucers operate on magnetic
principles. The saucers made just a
square turn off to the west. They really
seemed low to us, also seemed to be
going pretty slow for them.
