<p>10. BRIEF SUMMARY OF SIGHTING A/C sighted going SW with what appeared to be lights forming a circle. Lower than a commercial plane would fly and at about 1/3 speed. First impression was that obj looked like a floating mine. Obj was as large as DC-4 fm nose to tail w/lower half of obj vague. Circles of lights around center appeared to be moving as in a theatre marquee. Lights large in comparison to remainder of obj. Sound similar to a/c flying very high. Lights moved fm left to right on SW flight & right to left on</p>		<p>11. COMMENTS Sighting has all characteristics of a/c with advertising banner of lights. Check of local flights at this date not feasible as the obj is within present capabilities of conventional a/c & does not present a threat to security of the U.S. return.</p>
