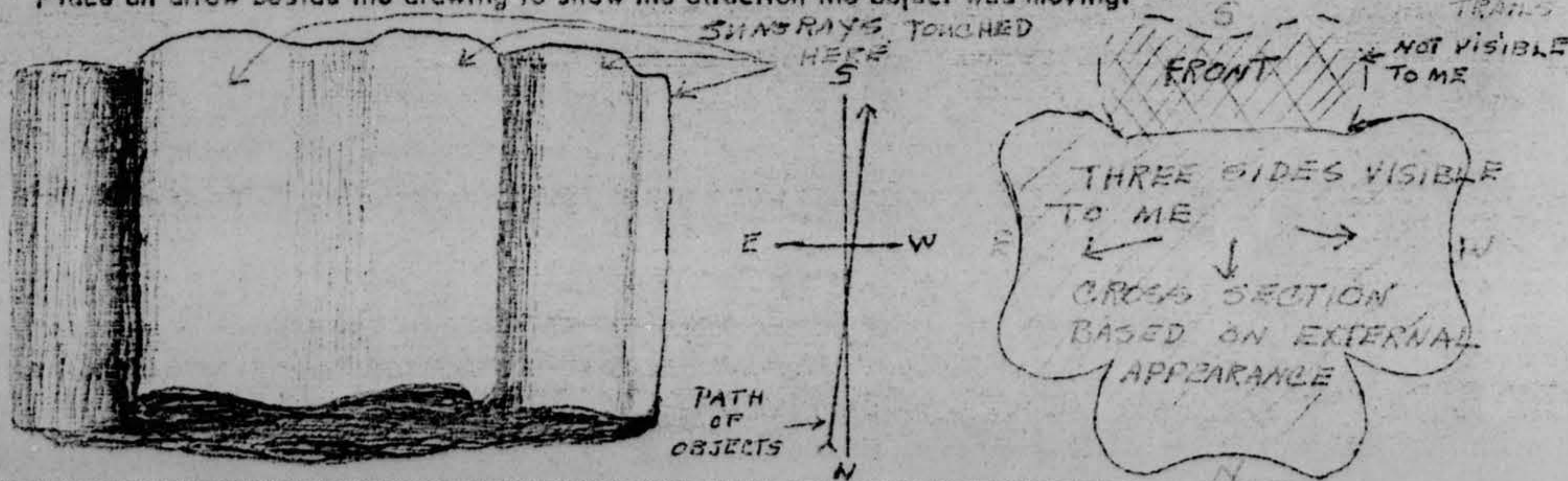

IN MY REPORT TO MAJ. KEYHOLE, I ESTIMATED EACH OBJECT TO BE ABOUT THE SIZE OF ONE INCH ON RULER HELD AT ARMS LENGTH - SINCE THEN I HELD A RULER TO A GOODYEAR BLIMP AND THE ONE INCH COVERED THAT. SO I WAS AT ERROR IN THAT ESTIMATE. THE MATCH HEAD COMPLETELY COVERED THE ROUND PART OF OUR TRAFFIC HELICOPTOR, I HAD THE FEELING EACH OBJECT WAS PERHAPS SLIGHTLY LARGER THAN THE BODY OF A HELICOPTOR - THEY WERE HIGHER - SO PROBABLY THE MATCH HEAD WOULD HAVE COVERED HALF OF ONE OBJECT.

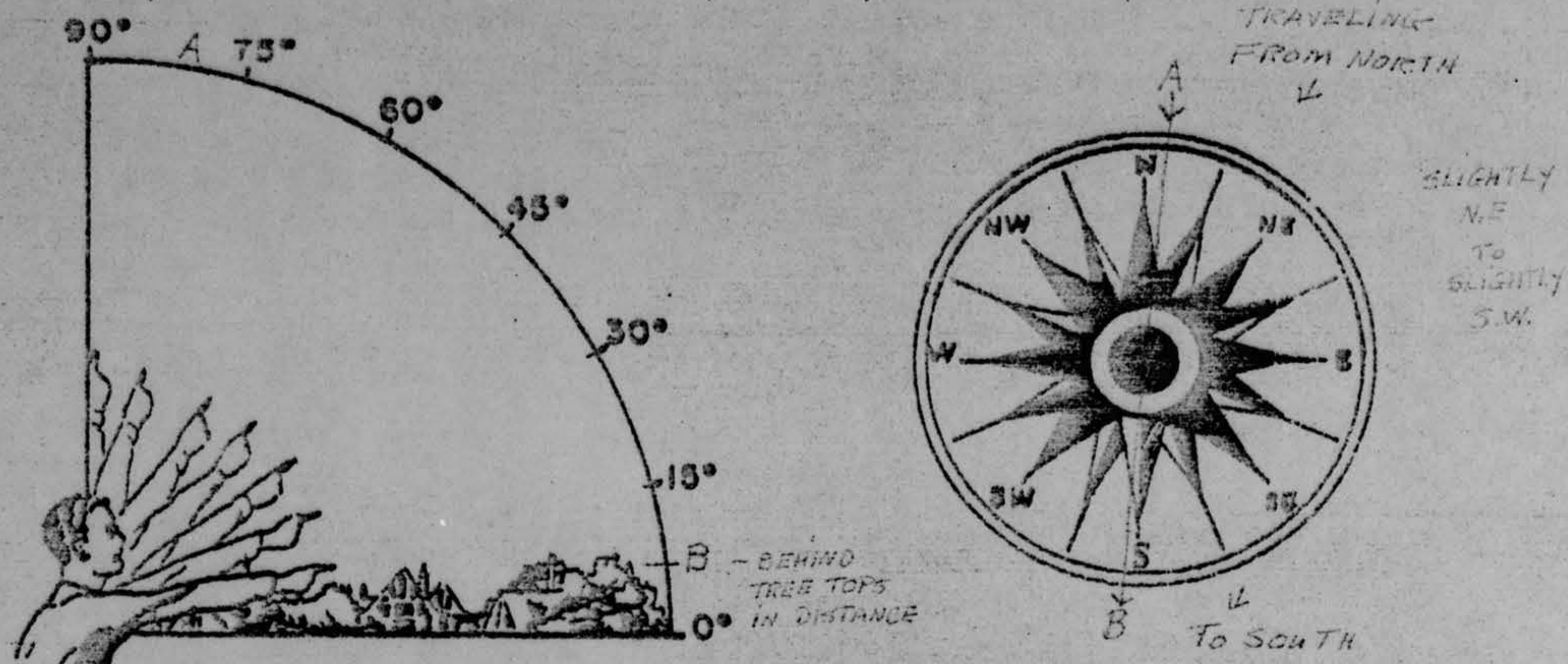

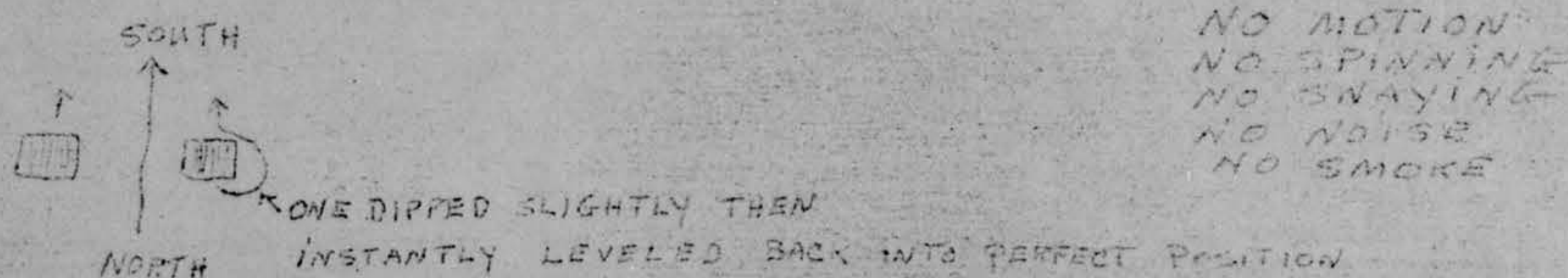

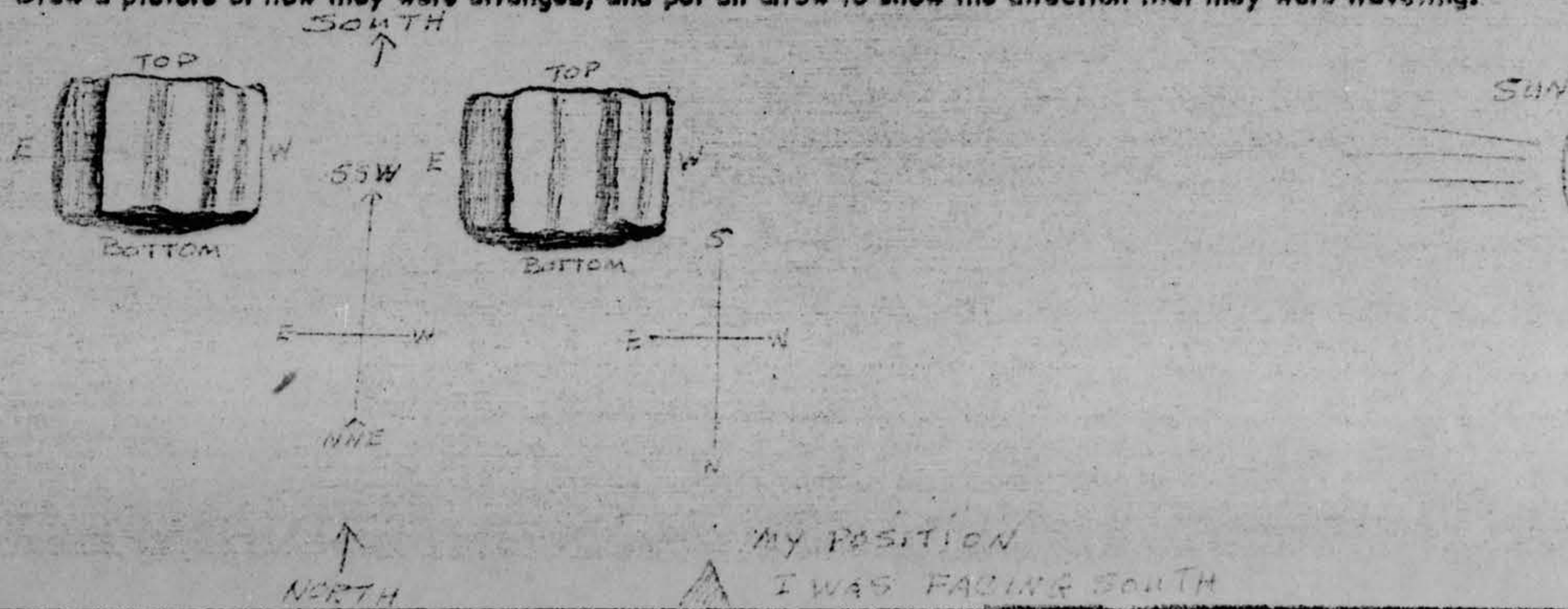

I WAS SITTING ON MY BACK PORCH. THERE ARE TREES ON BOTH SIDES OF OUR YARD, PERMITTING AN UNOBSTRUCTED VIEW OF THE SKY. OUR HOUSE FACES NORTH - PORCH ON SOUTH SIDE. I WAS FACING SOUTH.

SUDDENLY BIRDS CAME FLYING OVERHEAD FROM THE NORTH. THEY SEEMED EXCITED AND DISTURBED ABOUT SOMETHING. I LOOKED UP AT THEM AND SAW THESE TWO METAL OBJECTS, ALMOST DIRECTLY ABOVE ME. THEY WERE GLEAMING WHERE THE SUN'S RAYS HIT THEM.

I COULD SEE THEM DISTINCTLY + NEVER TOOK MY EYES OFF THEM, UNTIL THEY DISAPPEARED IN THE DISTANCE - TWO TINY BLACK SPECKS STILL IN PERFECT FORMATION.

THEY WERE NOT DRIFTING NOR SWAYING, BUT FLYING IN A STRAIGHT COURSE AND WERE ~~DEFINATELY~~ ^{DEFINATELY} BEING GUIDED SKILLFULLY. THEY WERE FLYING SWIFTLY + SILENTLY.

I TALKED WITH A FRIEND IN THE WEATHER BUREAU - THE BALLOONS THEY SEND UP ARE - ONE LARGE SILVER BALLOON WITH A TAIL, ON THE END OF WHICH IS A SMALLER BALLOON. IN A STIFF WIND, THE SMALLER ONE BOBS UP + DOWN TO THE REAR OF THE LARGER ONE.

THESE OBJECTS I SAW WERE IDENTICAL IN SIZE AND SHAPE, WERE FLYING SIDE BY SIDE IN A STRAIGHT, UNWAVERING COURSE, FROM NORTH TO SOUTH, OR FOLLOWING THE HUDSON RIVER.

THEY WERE STRANGE + ALIEN TO ME, AND I THOUGHT SOMEONE IN AUTHORITY SHOULD BE NOTIFIED. NO ONE PAID ANY ATTENTION TO WHAT I WAS TRYING TO TELL THEM. THE COMMANDING OFFICER AT THE WATERVLIET ARSENAL TOLD SOMEONE TO TELL ME, THAT IT WAS AN OPTICAL ILLUSION.

IT CERTAINLY WAS NOT AN ILLUSION. I SAW THOSE THINGS AS CLEARLY + DISTINCTLY AS I CAN SEE AN AIRPLANE OR A HELICOPTOR IN THE SKY.

THE BRUSH-OFF I RECEIVED HERE BURNED ME UP, AND THEN I WROTE THAT LETTER TO YOU.

I HAVE RECEIVED A LETTER FROM MAJ. DONALD E. KEYHOF, RET. OF NICAP, WITH LITERATURE + INFORMATION ABOUT LIFE'S AND FORMS TO BE FILLED OUT.

I STILL DO NOT BELIEVE IN OBJECTS FROM OUTER SPACE OR FROM OTHER PLANETS.

I STILL BELIEVE THESE OBJECTS COULD BE HIGH POWERED, REMOTE CONTROLLED CAMERAS, LAUNCHED FROM A SHIP AT SEA.

WE ARE FOREVER HEARING REPORTS THAT SEVERAL RUSSIAN SHIPS HAD BEEN SIGHTED, ANCHORED OFF THE EASTERN COAST AROUND NEWFOUNDLAND — AND SO YOU CAN TAKE IT FROM THERE.

THERE ARE MANY VITAL GOVERNMENT INSTALLATIONS IN THIS AREA. I DON'T BELIEVE THESE OBJECTS WILL BE BACK IN THIS AREA, THEY HAVE WHAT THEY WANT.

I SAW SOMETHING STRANGE THAT MUST BE INVESTIGATED. IF THEY ARE SECRET MISSILES OUR OWN GOVERNMENT IS TESTING, THEN I THINK I DESERVE SOME SORT OF EXPLANATION, BECAUSE I SAW THEM.

IF THEY ARE NOT OURS, THEN THE U.S.A.F. HAD BETTER GET ON THE BALL.

IF I HAVE NOT EXPLAINED EVERY THING CLEARLY ENOUGH OR IF THERE ARE MORE QUESTIONS YOU WOULD LIKE ANSWERED — I WOULD BE ONLY TOO GLAD TO HELP IN ANY WAY I CAN.

I APPRECIATE HEARING FROM YOU, I KNOW NOW THAT YOU ARE DOING SOMETHING ABOUT THESE REPORTS, SOME REPORTS NO DOUBT ARE FILLIMENTS OF IMAGINATION — BUT BELIEVE ME, THESE THINGS I SAW WERE VERY REAL.

MEVANDS IS A SMALL VILLAGE LOCATED ABOUT TWO (2) MILES NORTH OF ALBANY, NEW YORK.

Dear Sir;

I have never believed in the reports of flying saucers nor of other unidentified Flying Objects, claimed sighted by various people at different times and in different localities. The supposition that these objects were piloted by little green men from outer space, in my mind was pure balony and still is.

On August 11th past-at about 7:25 P.M. I was sitting on my back porch watching birds flying around, when two gleaming silver objects came into view over the roof of my porch. I have extremely good eyesight and am not an excitable person and I certainly was not hopefully looking for something strange to fly past in my line of vision.

These objects were flying quite low, made absolutely no noise, no smoke and were not spinning. One dipped slightly, then jerked back into position, as though pulled by a string. They were flying from North to South- following the Hudson River. I watched them until they became two little black specks in the distance.

They were not round- they were not flat as saucers.

The sky was bright and clear and I got a good thorough look at them. They were not optical illusions-not mirages and not jittery dreams of my own imagination. They were real!

Could they not have been two high powered, remote controlled camera's launched from a ship at sea?

No one in authority will listen to my description of them. I have *been* told "They do not exist." That they were an optical illusion. Well.- I know better--I saw them. They do exist!

Our government is spending Billions of Dollars, trying to put men on the moon before the Russians do--while the Russians could be spending their money taking pictures of our entire country.

Each was five or six feet across, according to her estimate.

After I reported sighting these objects- an announcement was made on our local Television station to this effect, "There have been reports that silver flying objects were sighted in this area. After careful investigation by authorities, this conclusion was reached-"No such objects exist." By the time anyone got around to investigating these reports, the objects in question were Gone.

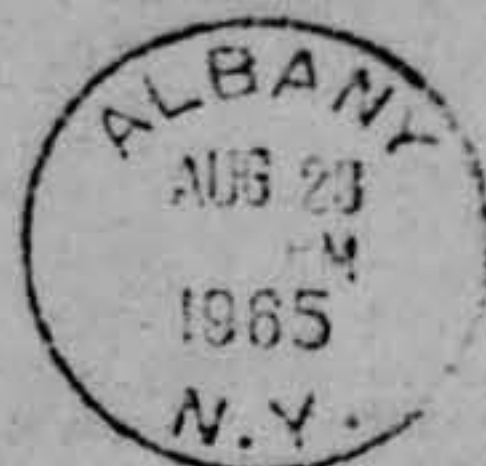
I drew pictures of what I saw. If anyone is interested in seeing them and hearing my description, (and believe me, someone should be) I will be glad to show them and explain what I saw.

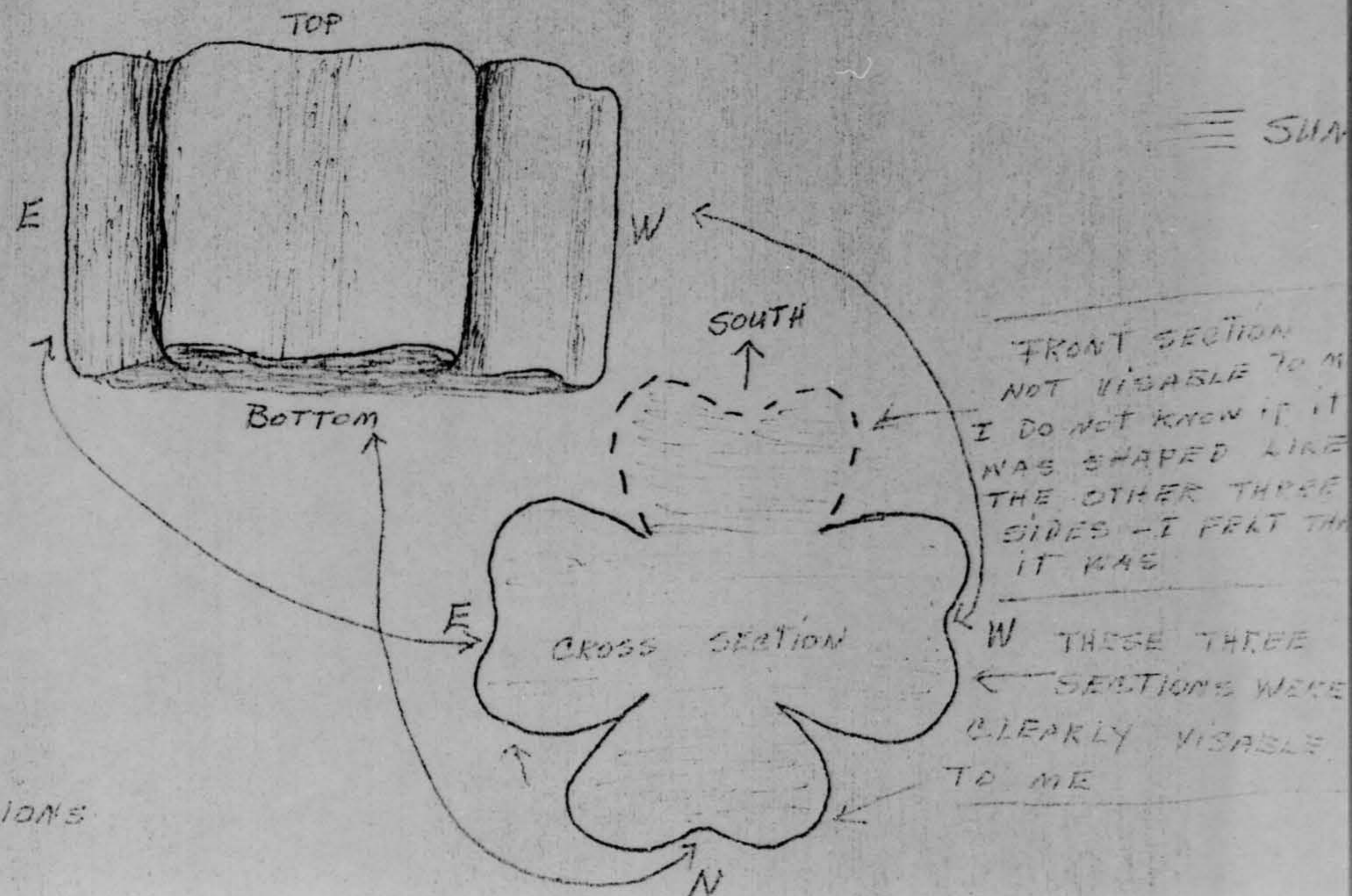

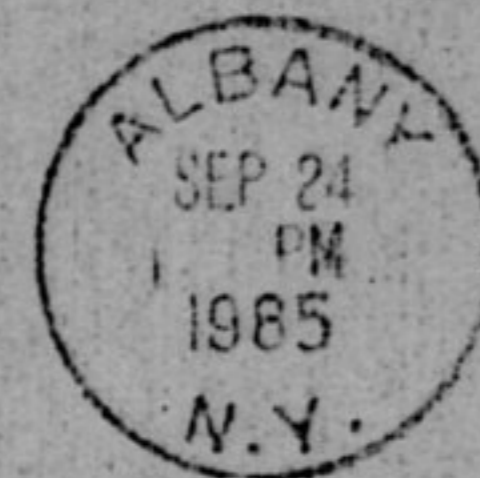
