After watching it for a while we crossed over to the rear of my house. From there we could see another red object that was more toward the east, just about the position where the moon rises, although it was now in the west and in the first quarter. We then went back, to watch from the other position. Both these objects could not be seen from the same position because of the trees obstructing the view. I gave up my watching to go home.

Before entering the house, I went once more to the rear, and just as I looked up I saw a large red object with a silver dome, crossing very silently, from east to south-west. I ran very quickly to look from the other position. Helen was still watching. As I arrived it had just crossed over the high tension wires, behind the trees, and out of view. As I began to turn I said "LOOK", and to the left, from the very same direction, came another and another, and, another. Four in all. The first having the lead was out of view; but the three following were one behind the other. We could see all three at the same time.

We listened for some kind of sound but heard none. The time was about 9:30. The other two red objects reduced in size and turned to white. The time was now between 9:30 and 9:45 p.m., and we also sighted a USAF experimental plane flying overhead. At first we thought it was another UFO but soon realized, from the span of the wings, that it definitely was a plane with all the bright lights that lit up the craft so that it created a beautiful sight, almost directly over our heads. About 10:15 p.m., both red objects vanished.

Probe Comment: These two ladies are very sincere and open-minded; not excitable or seeking publicity - but rather - willing to share what they have seen with others.

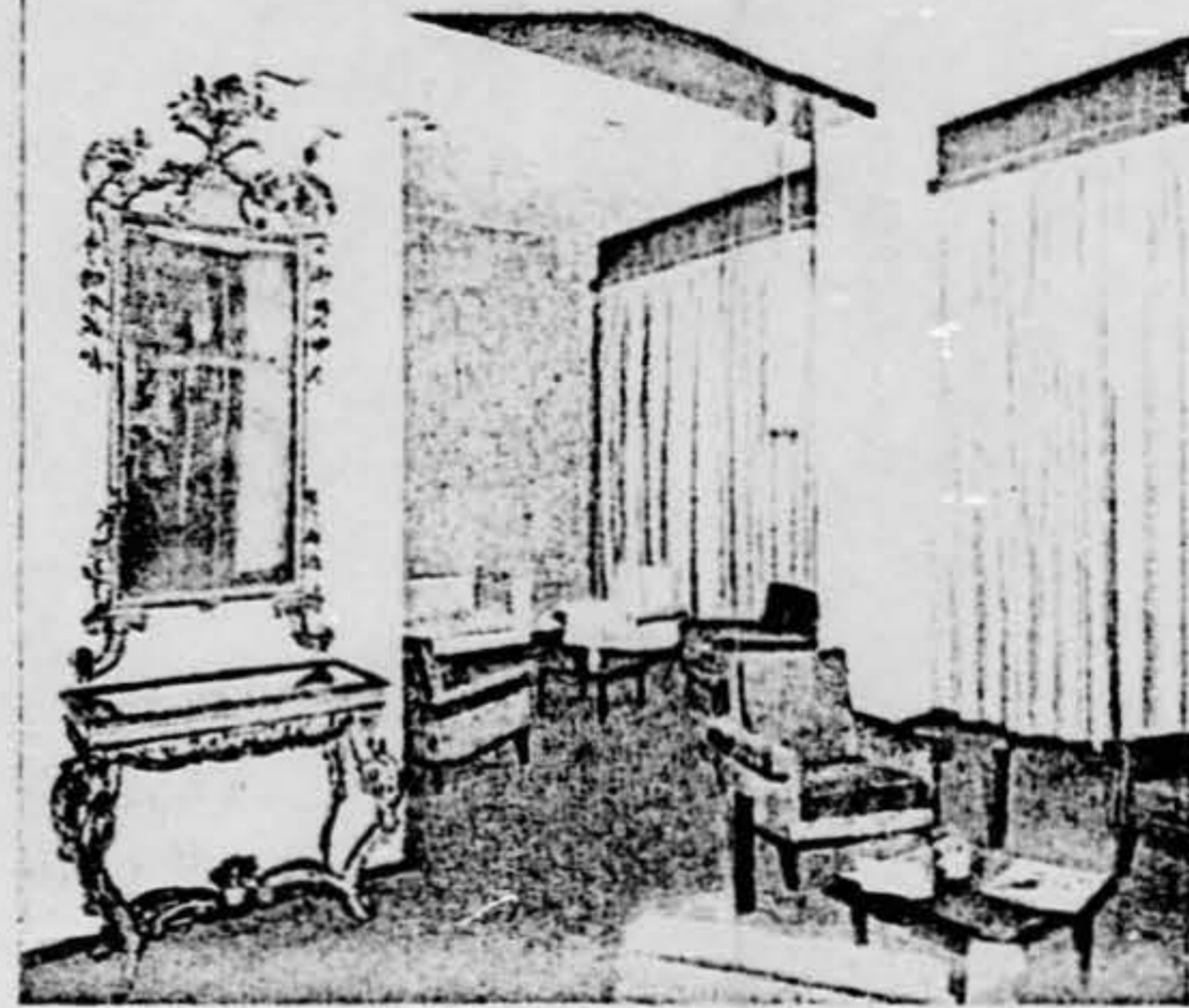
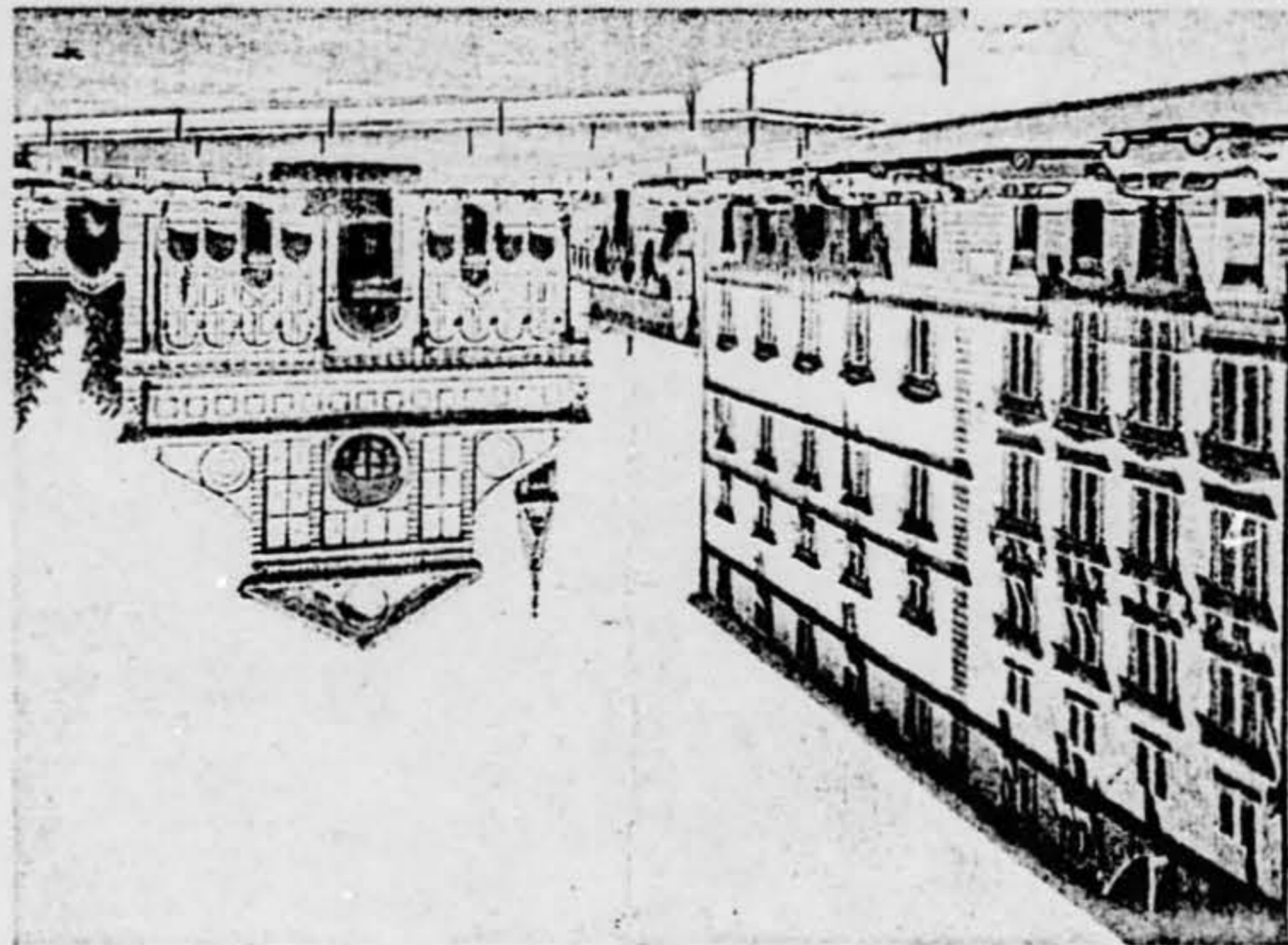



I am writing a report concerning several UFO's witnessed by myself and several others who were with me at different times.

The first and most prominent one was an object I saw flying between my home and Kansas City. The object, when I first saw it, was about the size of a street light at a distance of one hundred yards away. This was on the night of May 23, 1966. The object seemed to be shaped as thus: . BACKGROUND:

Miss [REDACTED] came to me at Sylvania with news of the object that she, her boyfriend and cousin had witnessed. The picture she drew of the object was impressive as it was near-identical to the objects sighted over Beverly, Mass. on April 22nd.

SIGHTING:

The witnesses described an oval object with bright rotating red, green and white lights. Its apparent size was that of a dime held at arms' length. Its brightness was compared to that of the moon which was also visible in the sky. [REDACTED] first noticed it hovering and alerted others who joined her in an automobile to try to get closer to it. At the closest point it seemed to be about 600 feet away and at fairly low level. Lower than airplanes normally fly. It was in the vicinity of the Watertown Arsenal. Total viewing time varied with witnesses between 5 - 10 minutes.

EVALUATION:

None of the witnesses are trained observers but all were certain that the object was not an aircraft because it was low enough to see its oval configuration clearly. Due to a very busy schedule we were not able to check this sighting out thoroughly as we would have liked to. I was told by others that a radio station announced sightings of a UFO over Watertown that evening but this was not followed up. Nothing appeared in newspapers reporting UFO sightings on this night. Although there is much information to be desired in this sighting, I felt as if it should be reported because of the similarity of the witnesses' description to the Beverly, Mass. and other sightings during the months of March and April.
