REMARKS: AT THE BEGINNING OF THE SIGHTING, THE OBSERVER THOUGHT IT  
WAS A LIGHT ACRAFT BURNING. FIRE GAINED IN INTENSITY AND THEN  
BEGAN TO BREAK UP. THE PIECES BREAKING OFF WERE BURNING AND ALL  
BURNED OUT BEFORE HITTING THE GROUND.
