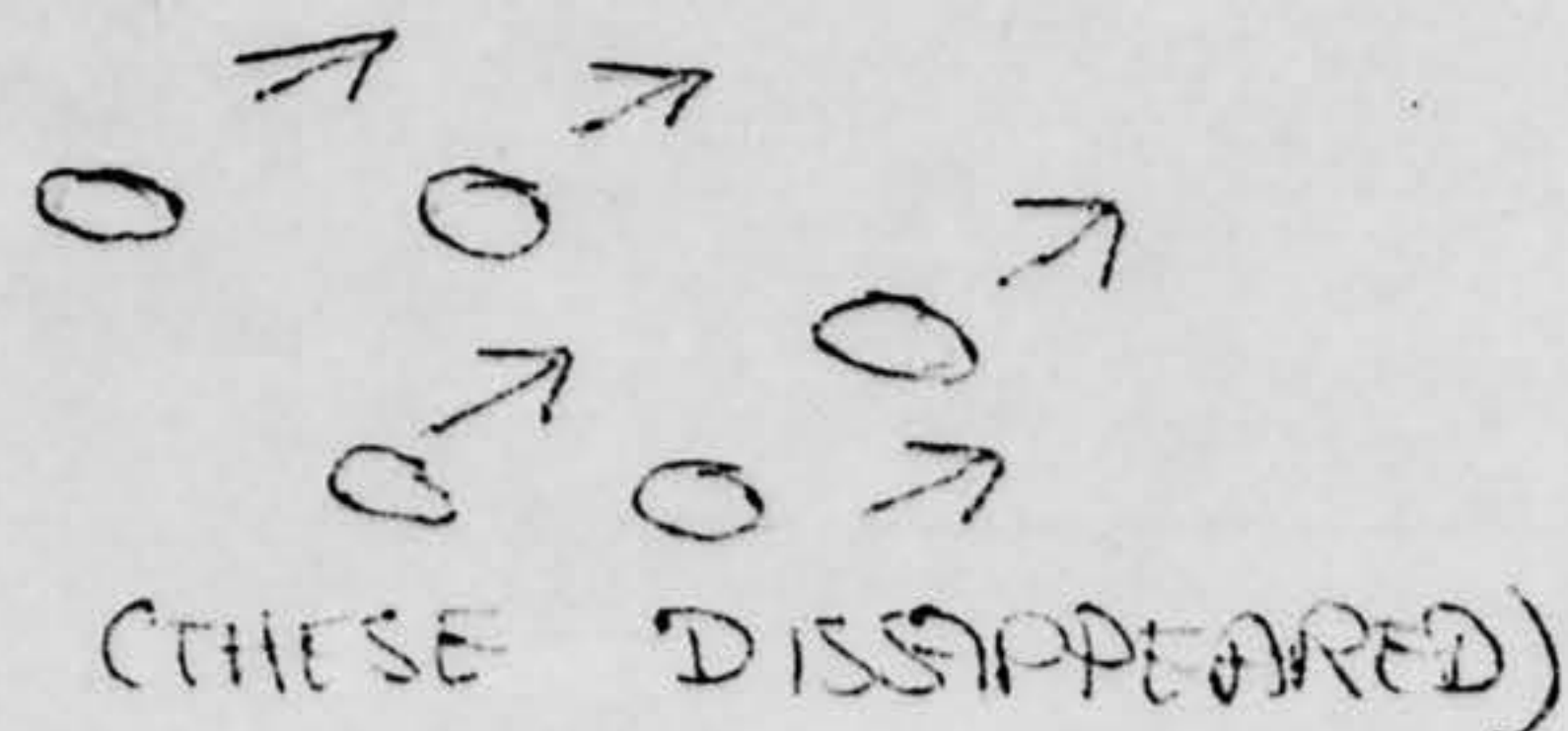

Two Report Seeing UFOs

Two persons reported seeing unidentified flying objects over the Daytona Beach Area Tuesday night.

Walter Woodruff and his son, Bill, 14, reported spotting a UFO at about 9:15 p.m.

"We were sitting in our living room watching television when we first noticed a large object coming toward our window," said Woodruff.

Woodruff said he and his son watched the hexagonal shaped object for about five minutes as it remained stationary about a quarter mile from their home at 10 S. Peninsula Drive. He said it began moving south, made an abrupt turn to the east and continued over the ocean. They observed the object, lit with blue, green, red and yellow lights, for about 20 minutes, he said.

Mike Pruitt, 1612 Elgin Drive, reported spotting a UFO between 10:30 and 11, while on the beach about one mile north of Granada Ave. in Ormond Beach. The round object had a small square base underneath and no lights, he said. "It was the reflection of the street lights off the base" that made it visible, Pruitt said.

The UFO was about 150 feet over his head, moving from east to west at 20 to 25 mph, according to Pruitt.
