To whom it may concern;

On the evening of June 21, at approximately 8:10 pm my friend and I sighted an unusual object in the air due North North West from our house, it was very unusual in that it seemed to come straight down from nowhere and abruptly stopped then shot into the North Eastern direction and disappeared behind a bank of clouds, My friend's older brother however did not see the object due to the fact that it happened so suddenly and was gone in a few brief seconds, being that we live so close to the Tulsa International Airport we are positive that it was neither airplane nor satellite. In the few brief seconds we saw it we could tell it was no conventional aircraft it had no wings that we could see and it was circular in shape and very bright. At approximately three hours later we were looking at the stars through my binoculars when one of the group sighted

another strange object moving in a north Easterly direction with a considerable rate of speed since we had binoculars we took advantage of the opportunity and all of the group looked at it through the binoculars, due to the bright light emitting from it, we could not make out an outline, It was low enough that we could tell it had no running lights as an airplane does, we took three time exposures with our camera which is a Bell & Howell Electric Eye 127 which is in excellent condition we took the film to the drug store, and left it to be developed, when we went back to get it on the assigned day the film hadn't come in, and we were told to come back the next day. We returned the following day and received our pictures but there were no pictures of our U.F.O and there were no negatives of the pictures we took.
