Neither my husband nor I have ever been subject to hallucinations of any kind nor are we likely to report anything that did not seem extremely extraordinary to us as we both know how many things can contribute to the appearance of an unfamiliar object (hallucinations, gasses, etc.) However, nothing in our own minds could explain what we saw. Also, I have flown in planes many times and my husband was in the Air Force, thus giving him a knowledge of many types of aircraft.

35. Information which you feel pertinent and which is not adequately covered in the specific points of the questionnaire or a narrative explanation of your sighting.

One thing that was not clearly defined was that the object we saw, which appeared as a bright light, went off and on as it traveled across the sky.

The periods of illumination were approximately 5-8 seconds apart, and very even. It had no color and no resemblance whatsoever to an airplane's lights - being much larger and what appeared to be a complete object unto itself (no outlines of anything around it.)

There were searchlights in the sky that night but we were convinced it was not one of these because it had no beam connected to it and was intermittent in its flashing. We are certain it was not a plane because it must have been flying low to get under the cloud cover and yet there was no sound. It was also traveling too rapidly for any plane we know of, had no vapor trail and managed to cross the entire sky <sup>in</sup> ~~at~~ ~~a~~ ~~little~~ <sup>approximately</sup> one minute. It did not look anything at all like a meteor, a comet or a satellite.







Dear Sirs:

We are not sure if such an individual account would be helpful to you or not, but my husband and I thought we should report an extremely unusual sight which we saw in the sky last night, and which was unlike anything we had ever seen before.

We are residing temporarily (until August 6) at the Blue Ridge School which is 18 miles north west of Charlottesville, Virginia near the small towns of Dyke and Standardsville. At approximately (and we are not sure of the exact time) 10:30-11:00 pm we were sitting by the school swimming pool when my husband suddenly called my attention to a bright, flashing object moving very rapidly across the sky. This object seemed to both of us to be a very strong burst of light that went off and on at regular intervals -- about five seconds apart, and moved in what appeared to be a very straight arc overhead, from horizon to horizon. In our discussion of it afterwards, we had only one area of disagreement, in that it appeared to be distinctly oval to me in shape and he had not noticed this and said it seemed to be to him only a "flash of light."

I would not be writing this note except for the unusual character of the object we saw. The cloud ceiling was low, and the object moved below this ceiling. It was certainly within small aircraft range, we would guess, if not lower. The flashes of light that it emitted were exceedingly bright, although they did not light up the night air with any kind of luminescence, being only in their own area.

What convinced us that this was something unusual was that the "craft" was travelling at an incredible speed. We estimated that it went from horizon to horizon in nearly twenty seconds. (Again may I say that we only saw light flashes and not an outline of any object.) The Charlottesville airport is nearby, but these flashes of light were totally different from any airline landing lights either of us has seen, and moved far too rapidly for an incoming plane -- even a jet. Secondly, there was absolutely no sound connected with the light which convinced us it was not a plane. It also could not have been a searchlight -- we could see these in the distance and the night, although cloudy, did allow us to see a continuous beam from the searchlights around us. This "object" did not seem to emit any sort of beam, but only very startling and isolated flashes of light.

Neither of us is susceptible to fancies of our imagination, nor are we great followers or believers of U.F.O. reports. But this was an experience that we felt should be reported. Perhaps it may be of service to you.

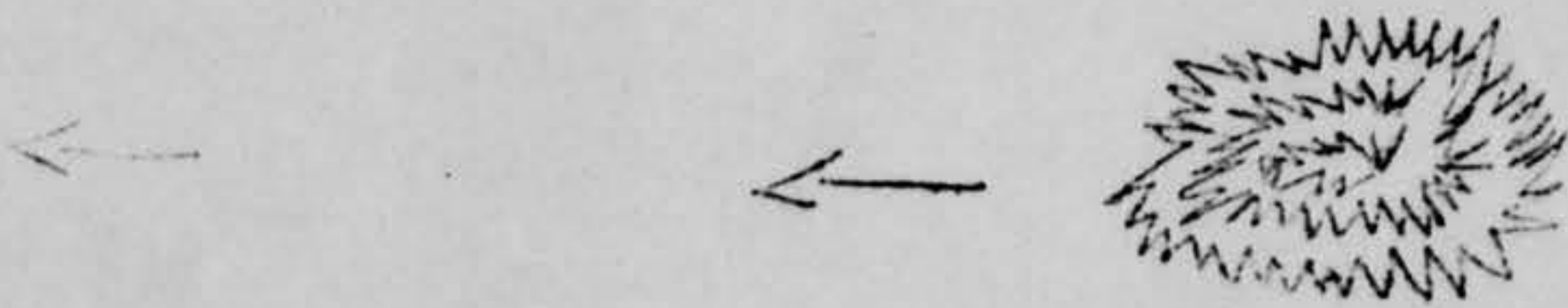
