My father dropped me off at our house and then he left to go visit my mother at the hospital. He remembered later that he had looked at his watch just before I got out of the car and it was eight o'clock p.m. When I first saw the object it was almost straight up in the sky and ~~very~~ very bright white light. The object stood perfectly still for at least 30 seconds. It seemed like it was going straight up for a while because the light slowly became smaller. Then it flew off as it turned red at what seemed a higher altitude. After it became very small I went inside to call the Air Force and when I came back outside I could not see it, I know that jets have red lights and that they appear to be stationary when they are gaining altitude. In my opinion the red light was too bright and too large for a jet. There are several red antenna warning lights about five miles to the north of my house. I know that the object was not an antenna light. The object flew well past the warning lights.

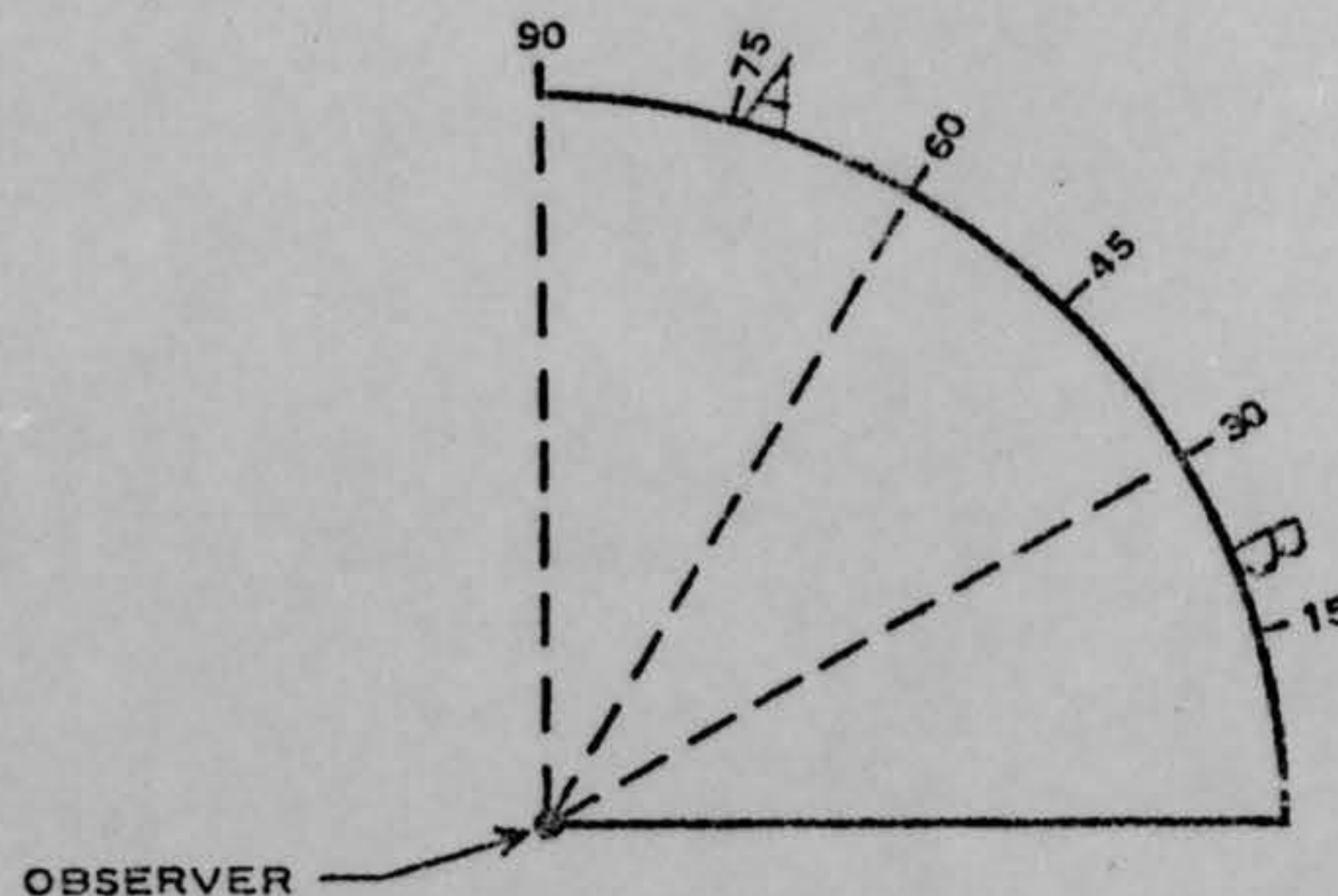

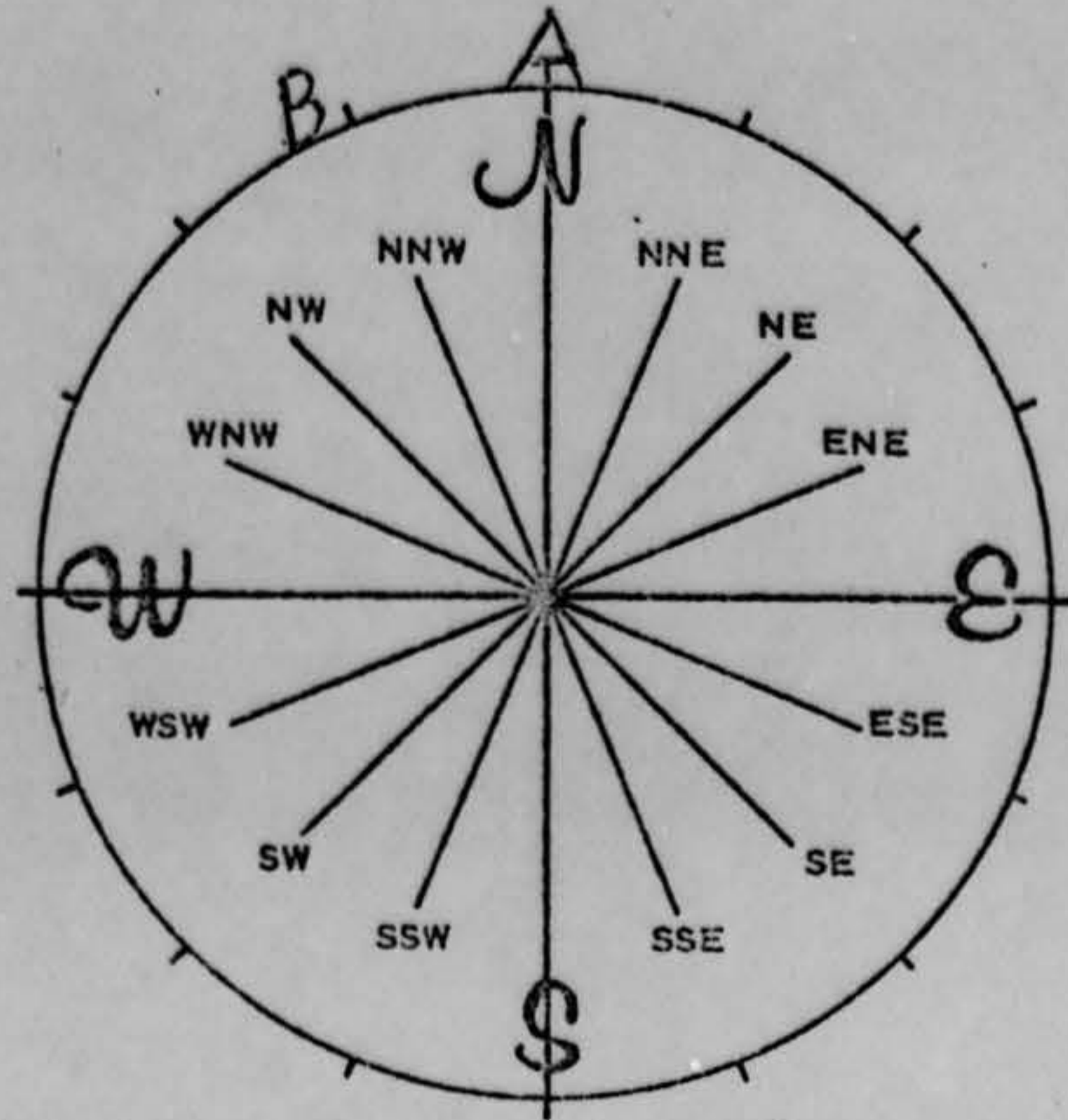

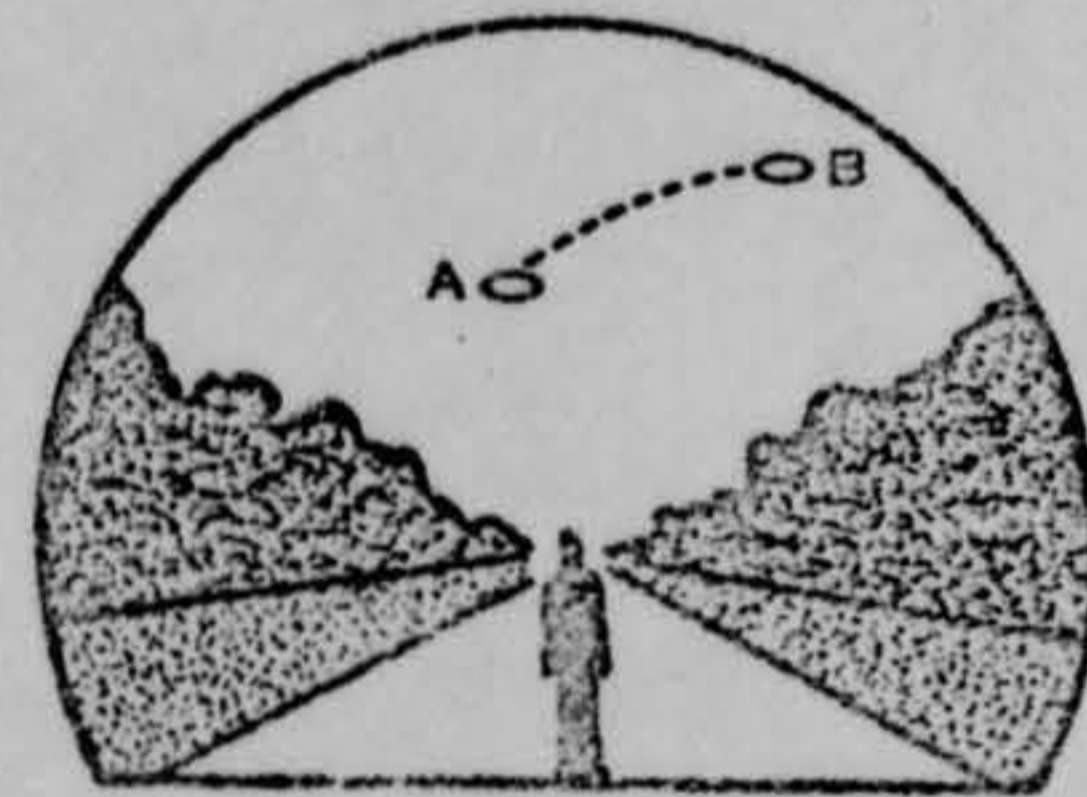
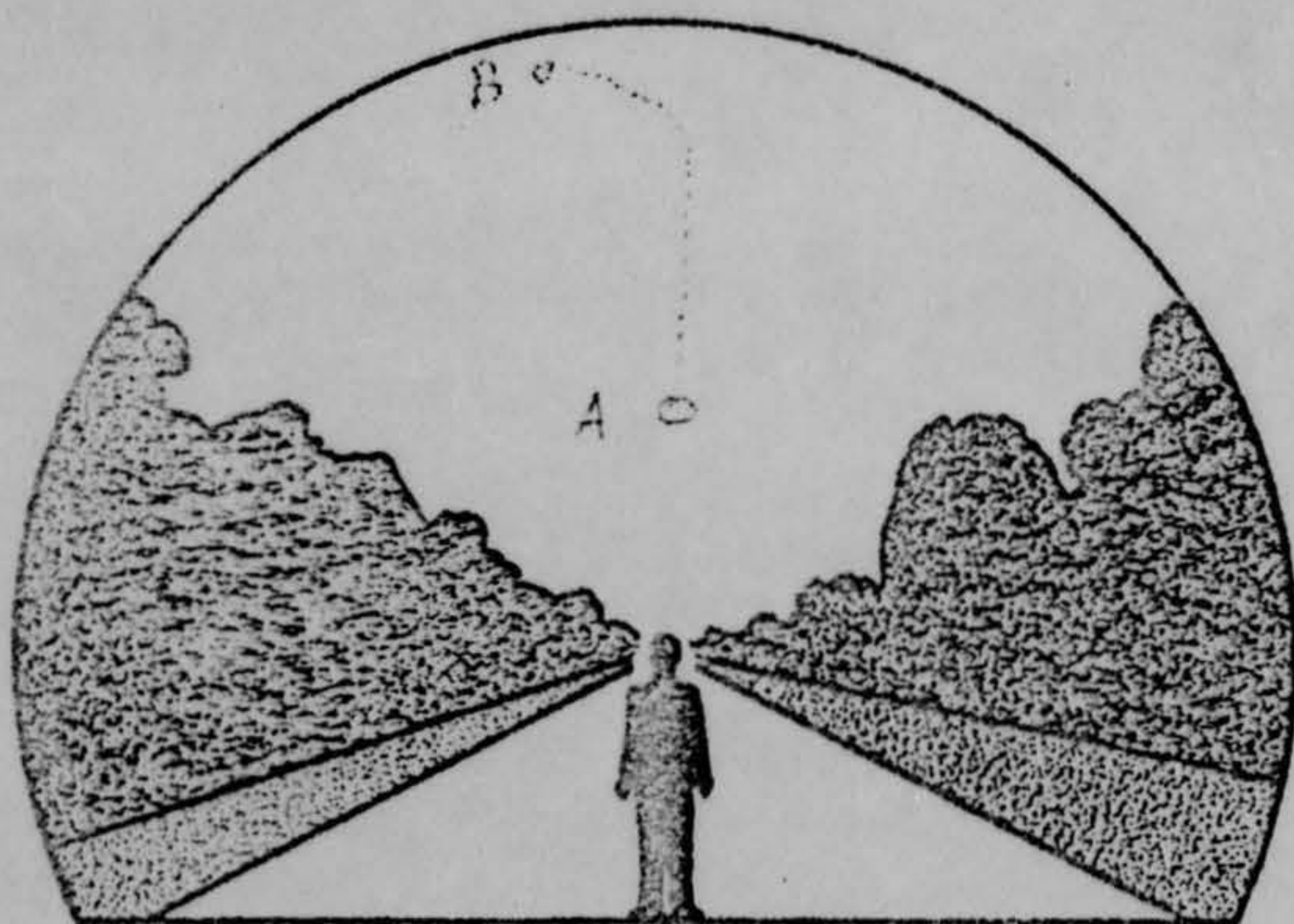

After turning red the object was about one fourth its original size. The size was hard to judge because the object was moving away from me very fast. I can describe the object only as a point of light. I saw no evidence of its being solid.*

The object was bright and seemed to be lower than an airplane. This made me ~~curious~~ curious but when the object moved away without any noise and turned red I knew this was very unusual.

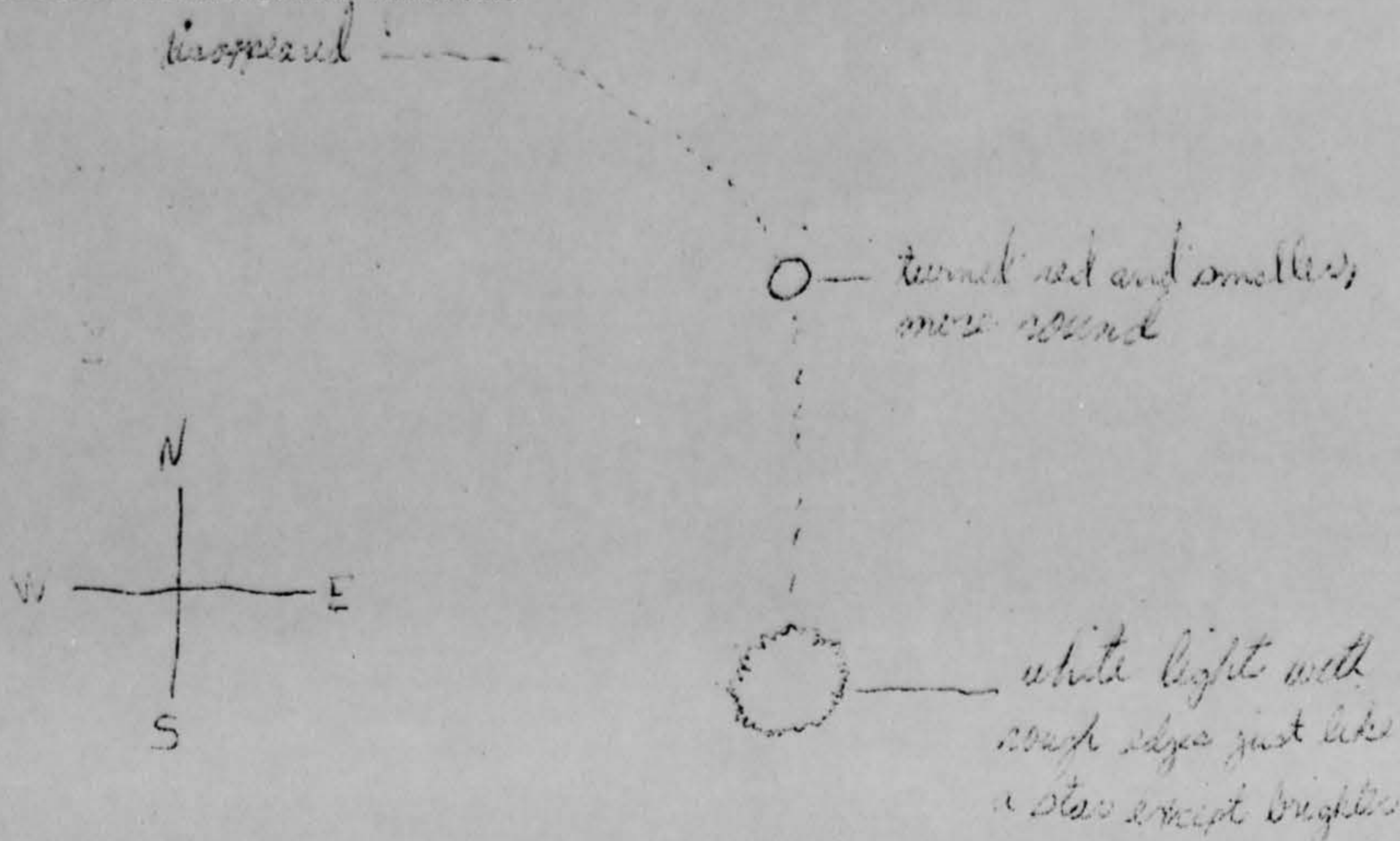
