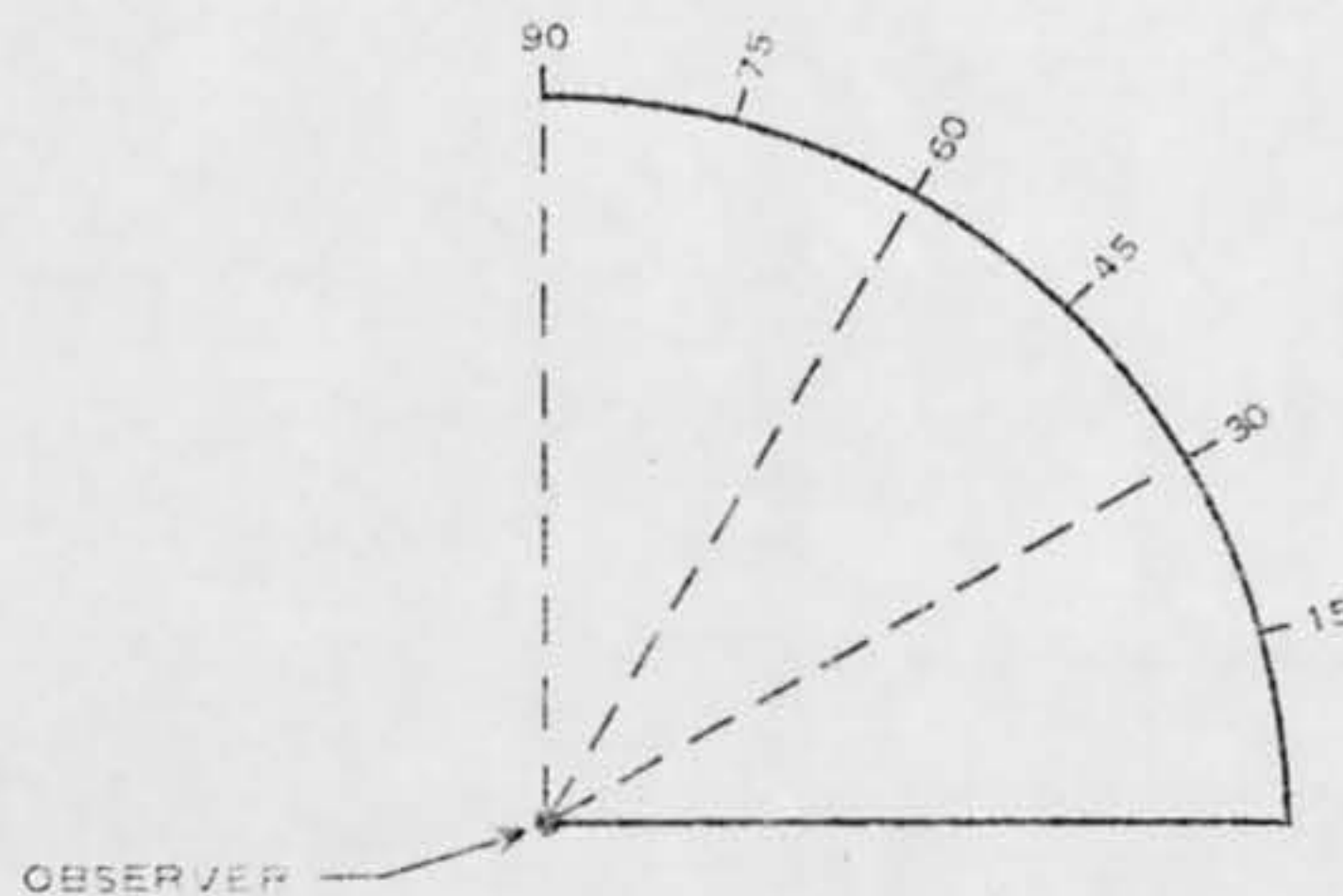

1. In response to your request I have reviewed the data concerning the UFO sighting which occurred 1 July 1968 in New Philadelphia, Ohio.
2. The atmospheric data presented with the report does not indicate the existence of any unusual weather phenomena which could explain this sighting.
3. I noted a number of inconsistencies in the report. For example, one individual reported the movement of the object in an opposite direction from that stated by the other observer. One report indicates the weather was partly cloudy; another reports it was clear.
4. I note in one sketch of the location the observer depicts an underpass - it is entirely possible that light from the sun reflecting off of the underpass structure could have caused a projection such as mentioned in these reports. A strong imagination would be necessary to interpret this as a UFO.
5. Two sentences in the report would appear to imply at least two of the observers are (so called) UFO fans. By this I am referring to Mr. Newmunatis' repeated comment that he would like to help you in your investigations, and Miss Sue Winters' remark that "everyone thinks I am crazy."
6. In summary, as far as I am personally able to determine, it was, and will remain, a UFO.

Flaming Object Lights Sky, Startles Midstate Residents

A bright meteor-like object flashed across the sky last night, startling residents of the Central Pennsylvania area for miles around.

The object, described as having an "eerie bluish white color and bearing a fiery tail," was believed to have landed in the Seven Mountains, west of Lewistown, although eyewitnesses could not reveal the exact location.

Plane pilots as well as motorists and residents sitting outdoors noticed the object in the sky about 9:25 p.m., traveling in a west-northwest direction. It was described as "larger than a full moon high in the sky."

State Police at Lewistown, where the object reportedly landed, said a man in a field on Seven Mountains had noticed the flash and saw the meteor strike the ground, although they were unable to identify him.

The object was said to have been seen by persons in upstate New York, Northeastern Ohio and the Baltimore area, as well

as in Central Pennsylvania as far east as Harrisburg.

The Weather Bureau at Harrisburg said the object was either a meteorite or debris

from a space shot. It indicated there was a low cloud cover over Harrisburg at the time and the object would have had to be very low to be seen by so many spectators.

Edward Naylor, former president of the Astronomical Society of Harrisburg, did not see the object flashing across the sky here, but said several other members of the society called him to say that they had seen something "which appeared to be a lightning flash" at that time.

Naylor said that when a meteor strikes the Earth, it is called a meteorite and takes the name of the nearest post office. For example, in this case, it would be the Lewistown Meteorite.

He also cited the possibility of last night's flash being caused by satellites that had left its orbit and disintegrated.

Many calls by curious persons were made to the Patriot and City Hall in an effort to determine the source of the flash.

Fireball Takes A Night Ride

Thousands of area residents awoke this morning to discover that not even a night's sleep would erase the memory of a flaming meteor they saw through last night's warm skies.

The meteor was sighted here at 9:24 p.m. and scores of residents immediately reported it to police, The Evening News and radio and television news media.

For those who saw it, the meteor was reported as a large "ball of fire" with a long tail much like a comet.

DR. JOHN CAVANAUGH, curator of astronomy and planetarium director of Franklin and Marshall

College, said the meteor was highly colorful, apparently containing many minerals which provided its coloration.

Some resident sky watchers missed seeing the meteor, but reported the entire sky flashed white; some said their lawns were illuminated as if it were bright daylight.

Jack Betz, of 5000 Lancaster St., president of the Astronomical Society of Harrisburg, witnessed the spectacle from the society's observatory, a mile west of Lewisberry.

"IT WAS A TYPE of meteor classified as a fireball," he said. "It emitted a very intense pale, green light and it moved southeast to the northwest.

"After passing over the area where I was, it appeared to break up into smaller pieces and disappear into the cloud cover to the northwest."

Betz said the society would be interested in hearing from anyone who heard a noise from the meteor.

Betz said he has been observing sky phenomena for about 25 years and "that this is the first of this type I ever saw."

Approximately 100 preliminary reports from viewers said the meteor had landed north of Millersburg. State Police at Lykens, however, said this was not true. Other reports had the meteor landing north of Marysville and as far north as Williamsport and Bloomsburg.
