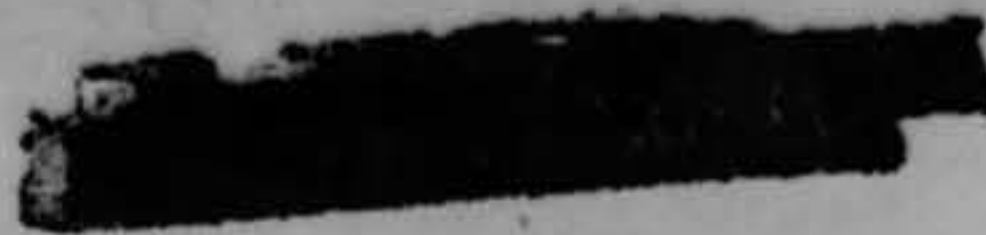

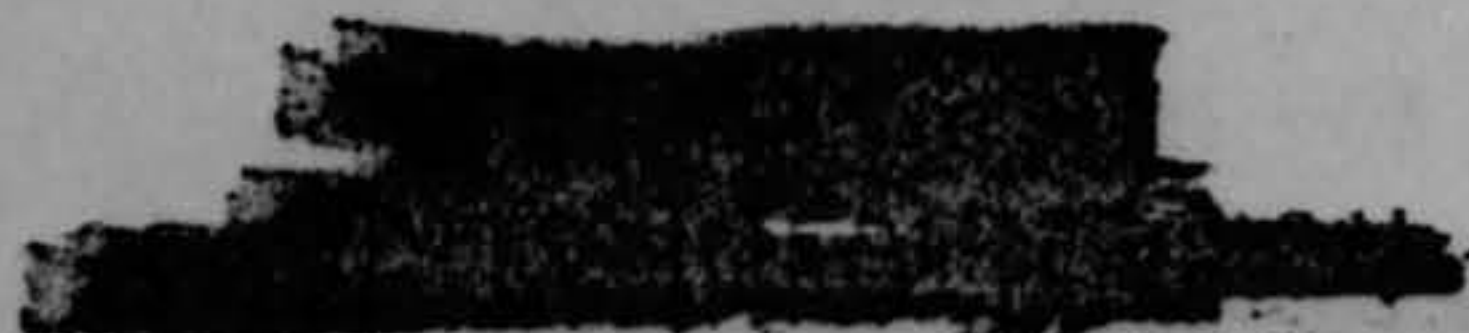
Several unidentified flying objects consisting, according to the many witnesses, of a white to orange red light, emitted from a rounded or diamond shaped object were sighted between 0154PST and 0342PST 26 July 1952. The object in almost all witness reports was stationary when first sighted then began a swinging motion, then began moving north and south around Palm Springs, California.

1. An unidentified diamond shaped flying object was sighted at 0154PST 26 July 1952. It was flashing blue and yellow and was sighted very high over Beaumont Pass, California, heading East.

a. At 0158PST a rounded or diamond shaped object was sighted over Palm Springs, California, appearing to move very fast although stopping at times.

b. At 0225PST an object was sighted moving North from Palm Springs putting out quite a lot of light.

c. At 0233PST the object was moving North and South around Palm Springs.

d. At 0306PST the object was observed standing still and had maintained a stationary position for a full 5 minutes.

e. At 0320PST the object seemed to be swinging back and forth between Palm Springs and San Jacinto Mountains.

f. At 0330PST as the object came closer it sounded like a jet engine.

g. At 0335PST another object was sighted moving eastward over Palm Springs very fast flashing a reddish orange color.

2. The above objects were seen by three women: [redacted]
Canyon Drive, Palm Springs, California; [redacted]
Palm Springs, California, and [redacted], Palm Springs, California.

3. At 0250PST Mr. [redacted], Belmont Springs, California, reported to be moving.

4. A Mr. [redacted] pilot of [redacted], a C-47, reported to Los Angeles Control that as he passed 25 miles South of Needles, California, at 0342PST he saw a light which appeared to be a landing light but lit up the ground approximately 30° and 5 miles to the right of his course. The aircraft was westbound into Los Angeles.

5. Thermal, California, weather at 0130PST was clear, visibility 20 miles, temperature 85, dewpoint 67, winds calm, altimeter 29.89. The weather remained clear with a visibility of 20 miles throughout the sighting period. Winds aloft at 10,000 feet were from 150° at 10 knots, 19,000 feet from 130° at 20 knots, 32,000 feet from 130° at 25 knots, 41,000 feet from 140° at 20 knots, 46,000 feet from 140° at 20 knots.

6. Known air traffic in the area through the sighting period was American 900, a DC-6, at 15,000 feet, eastbound over Palm Springs at 0132PST, and TWA Flight 5, A DC-4, westbound at 10,000 feet over Palm Springs at 0341PST.

Comments of Preparing Officer:

1. No observations concerning the aerial observer qualifications of the witnesses can be made. Witnesses were not interrogated.
